## OVERVIEW

The Strengthen Oklahoma Homes Program provides grants to Oklahoma residents for residential wind and hail mitigation on new and existing, owner-occupied, primary residence single-family homes. Funding for this program comes from the insurance industry in Oklahoma and is not funded from the state's general budget.

# **EFFECTIVE DATE: NOVEMBER 1, 2024 APPLICATION OPENING: EARLY 2025**

## **CRITERIA FOR GRANTS**

- Available to homeowners in all 77 counties of Oklahoma.
- Homes must be in good condition or have sustained damage from qualifying events like tornadoes, windstorms, or hail.
- Proof of active homeowners insurance with wind coverage and flood insurance if applicable.
- Home must be considered eligible for a FORTIFIED designation after eligibility inspection.

#### COVERAGE OF GRANTS

Grants cover enhancements required to obtain IBHS FORTIFIED Home(TM) - Roof designation. Improvements include enhanced roof deck attachment, impactresistant shingles, and wind-resistant attic vents.

# INSURANCE PREMIUM SAVINGS

Homes meeting FORTIFIED Home™ standards may qualify for up to a 42% discount on the wind portion of homeowners insurance premiums. Specific discounts vary by insurance carrier. Visit oid.ok.gov/okready for details.

# CONTRACTORS AND EVALUATORS
