# CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Glen Mulready, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel, Teresa L. Green, and alleges and states as follows:

### **JURISDICTION**

- 1. Glen Mulready is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and, as such, is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7401, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-40.
- 2. Respondent Iris Latishia Lawson ("Respondent Lawson") is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 100240992. Respondent Lawson's address of record is 215 W. Main St., Purcell, Oklahoma 73080.
- 3. Respondent Curtis Wayne Pletcher ("Respondent Pletcher") is a multicounty agent bondsman licensed in the state of Oklahoma holding license number 199574. Respondent

Pletcher's address of record is P.O. Box 66, Springer, OK 73458-0066.

- 4. The Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter raised in this dispute and may issue penalties pursuant to 59 O.S. §§ 1310 and 1332.
- 5. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), in addition to any potential denial, censure, suspension, or revocation, any person violating any provision of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act may be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$2,500.00 for each occurrence.
- 6. If Respondents request a hearing in writing in this matter, pursuant to OAC 365:1-7-1, the Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1311.1, will appoint an independent hearing examiner who shall sit as a quasi-judicial officer and preside over the hearing requested by Respondent.
- 7. The Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to OAC 365:1-7-5, upon written request reasonably made by a person affected by the hearing and at such person's expense, shall cause a full stenographic record of the proceedings to be made by a competent court reporter.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

8. On or about February 9, 2023, an appearance bond was filed as follows:

9. On or about April 13, 2023, the Defendant failed to appear in CM-2021-99. An Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued in CM-2021-99 on or about April 18, 2023, by the McClain County District Court. A true and correct copy of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture

was mailed to Respondent Lawson and Respondent Pletcher with return receipt requested within thirty (30) days after the Order's filing.

- 10. Respondent Lawson received a copy of the Order and Judgement of Forfeiture in CM-2021-99 on or about April 20, 2023.
- 11. Respondent Pletcher received a copy of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture in CM-2021-99 on or about April 21, 2023.
- 12. The ninety-first (91st) day after receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was July 20, 2023.
  - 13. The forfeiture in CM-2021-99 was paid on or about November 7, 2023.
- 14. Forfeiture was not timely paid, and the defendant was not timely returned to custody.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 15. Respondents have violated 59 O.S. 1310(A)(2) and (28), by failing to return the Defendant to custody within ninety (90) days or remit payment in the face amount of the bond forfeiture within ninety-one (91) days from receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture in accordance with the provisions of 59 O.S. § 1332 and OAC 365:25-5-40.
- 16. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), any bondsman violating a provision of the Bail Bond Act, 59 O.S. §§ 1301 et seq., may be subject to a fine of not less than \$250.00 but not more than \$2,500.00 per violation.

#### **ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent Lawson is FINED \$1,000.00 and Respondent Pletcher is FINED \$2,500.00. The fines are to be paid within 30 days of the date of

this Conditional Administrative Order and made payable to the Oklahoma Insurance Department.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless either Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Findings of Fact set forth above within thirty (30) days of the date of this Conditional Order, the penalties set forth above shall become a Final Order on the thirty-first (31st) day following the date of mailing this Order. A request for hearing should be in writing and addressed to Teresa L. Green, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 400 N.E. 50th Street, Oklahoma City, OK 73105. The request for hearing must state the grounds for the request to set aside or modify the Order.

Any such hearing will be conducted according to the procedures for contested cases under the Insurance Code and 75 O.S. § 250 et seq. If the Respondent serves a timely request for hearing on the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this Conditional Order will act as notice of the matters to be reviewed at the hearing, and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and penalties imposed in this Conditional Order will be considered withdrawn, pending final resolution at the hearing.
