





### **Instructions for Professionals**

# Step 1 – Hold or obtain a License with the Oklahoma Construction Industries Board (CIB) if applicable.

✓ Ensure you have a valid license with the Oklahoma CIB to be eligible for certification.

Requirements pursuant to CIB:

- Proof of General Liability Insurance of at least \$500,000
- Proof of Workers' Compensation Coverage
- Affidavit of lawful presence in the US
- Federal Tax ID

# Step 2 – Submit Provider Application to IBHS FORTIFIED to obtain an IBHS FORTIFIED Professional Certification.

- ✓ Create an Account:
  - Register for the IBHS FORTIFIED <u>Provider Portal</u> to begin your journey as a certified IBHS FORTIFIED service provider.
- ✓ Provide Credentials:
  - Upload specific credentials that demonstrate you meet the minimum eligibility.

Requirements pursuant to IBHS Fortified Certification:

- o Proof of General Liability Insurance of at least \$1 million
- o Proof of Workers' Compensation Coverage or satisfactory proof of exemption
- Proof of Professional liability of at least \$500,000 (not required but strongly recommended)
- Proof of years in business matching one of the following:
  - A licensed, or registered general contractor, residential contractor/builder, or building contractor- Minimum 5 years' experience.
  - An unlicensed residential or general contractor- Minimum 5 years in a supervisory capacity (team leader, project manager, or supervisor)
  - A registered, or licensed architect or engineer- Minimum 5 years' experience
  - An ICC-certified building code official- Minimum 3 years' experience
  - An ICC-certified residential code inspector- Minimum 3 years' experience and 250 verifiable home inspections
  - A licensed, or registered home inspector- Minimum of 3 years' experience and 250 verifiable home inspections

Requirements are also outlined in the FORTIFIED Professional Handbook.

- ✓ Review Process:
  - The IBHS FORTIFIED team will review your documentation to confirm your eligibility.

#### Step 3 – Complete IBHS FORTIFIED Training & Pass the Exam.

- ✓ Access Training:
  - Go to <u>FORTIFIED Wise University</u> and complete the online training course relevant to your company type (professional) and region for high wind.
- √ Pass the Exam:
  - Take the corresponding IBHS FORTIFIED certification exam and achieve a score of 85% or higher.
- ✓ Receive Certification:
  - Upon passing, you'll receive an email with your score and certificate. Save this document to upload to your profile in the IBHS FORTIFIED Provider Portal.

# Step 4 - Complete Profile in the Provider Portal

- ✓ Update Your Profile:
  - After passing the certification exam, return to the IBHS FORTIFIED <u>Provider Portal</u> to complete your registration.
- ✓ Upload Required Documents:
  - Submit your exam certificate, a signed Provider Agreement, and any additional credentials not previously provided:
    - FORTIFIED Professional Agreement
- ✓ Final Review:
  - The IBHS FORTIFIED team will review your documents. Once approved, your company will be listed in the IBHS FORTIFIED Directory.

# Step 5 - Register with OMES

✓ Register with OMES as a <u>supplier</u>.

#### Step 6 - Apply with the Oklahoma Strengthen Homes Program as an Approved Contractor

- ✓ Submit the Strengthen Oklahoma Homes Fortified Contractor Application and the following documentation to <a href="https://oks.gov">OKReady@oid.ok.gov</a> (add link to application):
  - o Oklahoma Tax Commission Compliance Letter
  - Provide Certificate of General Liability Insurance and Workers' Compensation Insurance
  - Certificate of Good Standing from Secretary of State
  - Provide a copy of your Valid and Active CIB Registration or other applicable Certification
  - o Provide a copy of IBHS Certification
  - Provide notification of any conflicts of interest
